PROJECT DESCRIPTION


Surgical support is a key factor in medical support improving operational sustainment. The changes in the EU's strategic environment, with new consequent scenarios, highlight the need for rapidly deployable, highly mobile, versatile and with a minimal logistical footprint Medical Treatment Facilities (MTF) to provide medical care, including initial surgery to the casualties in different domains: Air, Land, Maritime and Special Operations Forces. This MTF could facilitate the possibility to ensure the continuum of care providing a critical capability to the Force Commanders.

OBJECTIVES/PRODUCTS

The intent of this project is to increase the EU's joint operational efficiency by developing the concept of the ROLE2 Forward.

CRITERIA FOR SUCCESS

- Defining the conceptual development of the Medical Treatment Facility ROLE 2 Forward (MTF R2F) as the Surgical Facility of minor entity with high mobility that allows to provide Damage Control Resuscitation (DCR) and Damage Control Surgery (DCS).
- Establishing the characteristics of medical support based on the employment of the EU Rapid Deployment Capacity within the scenarios determined in the Strategic Compass.
- Addressing the capability gap identified by several EU countries.
- Once the project is completed, the concept will be shared with other structures, such as
 the EUMS. Depending of the project evolution, and if so is determined by the pMS, a
 continuation development project could be proposed, within the adequate framework, in
 order that nations and/or entities which so desire could collaborate in the further
 development of this capacity.
